A History of Terror—Local resident and guide, Mark, will walk us back in time and reveal many of the local stories that form a part of *The Troubles*—this is a very personal and unique experience to walk in the footsteps of the local communities.

What you will learn: This tour explains how *The Troubles* began. We tell the stories of the people involved, their place in the conflict and the effect these attacks and incidents had on the city and its people. We do all this from an

	entirely neutral, civilian perspective. The tour also shows how far the city has come since the ceasefires and Peace Process.
