



Pavestone Rally 2025 Event Disclaimer
To be returned at Event Registration (latest)
Mandatory signature required from all team participants



1. General Information

Pavestone rally 2025 is NOT a race or a driving competition. Apart from the NON-Driving related optional challenges you must NOT compete in any manner with other participants. You must not place any bets of any kind in relation to the event. You must drive safely and with proper courtesy to all other participants and members of the public, abiding by the relevant traffic laws applicable to the country in which you are driving.

2. Entry Fee

The Entry fee per person is £849+vat for Twin rooms or £1149+vat for single occupancy. The entry fee covers accommodation, ferry crossings, road tax (mandatory in Europe), Go Karting Challenge, European car kit and a presentation meal on the last night. The entry fee does not cover personal acquisitions, fuel, food/drink or any other expenses, liabilities, costs and disbursements incurred.

3. Driving compliance

You must comply with all applicable laws and regulations of the country in which you are travelling, including without limitation, all speed regulations, laws of the road, laws relating to the safety of your vehicle and laws relating to the possession or use of alcohol, drugs or other prohibited substances. **Bumping into or nudging other team cars, whether driving or parked is strictly prohibited.**

4. Responsibility

Pavestone accepts no responsibility for the consequences of you being refused passage and/or entry/exit to or from any country visited en route, and in particular any additional costs incurred are your own responsibility. **You are participating in this event entirely at your own responsibility and risk.**

5. Intoxicating substances

You must NOT consume alcohol while driving. You must NOT drive under the influence of alcohol or any other intoxicating substance at any time. You must NOT consume any illegal or intoxicating substance at any time during the event.

6. Safety

You must NOT drive if your ability to do so safely and properly is in any way compromised by illness, lack of adequate rest, or any other condition. It is your responsibility to ensure that your vehicle is in a road worthy condition to drive and if at any stage it is not, you must not continue on the event until any problems are rectified. A copy of a valid MOT must be provided at registration.

7. Indemnity

You will indemnify the organiser, its directors, officers, employees, agents, representatives and consultants against any and all claims, lawsuits and causes of action whatsoever or howsoever arising and brought against them by any third party as a result of your action or participation in the event, including without limitation, your violation of any laws or regulations or your breach of these terms and conditions of entry.

8. Licence

All drivers must hold and provide copies of current, valid and unrestricted driver's licences and all participants must hold current valid passports.

9. Insurance

You must provide proof that you have obtained appropriate insurance covering every member of the team's participations in the event. Appropriate insurance includes, without limitation, third party liability, and liability cover for yourself, medical, damage to property and life insurance. A valid copy of your insurance cover note/certificate must be available for checking at the beginning of the event.

10. Logo

You will be provided with a set of race number stickers to be applied to your vehicle if you wish. They should easily remove without damaging your bodywork, although Pavestone cannot be held responsible for any resulting damage from stickers.

11. Refunds

No refunds of the entry fee will be made under any circumstances. If any monies can be recouped from hotel bookings, this will be donated equally between our charities (Variety, Crash, Lighthouse & Teenage cancer trust)

12. Violation of Terms

If you violate any of the above terms and conditions or refuse to follow the instructions given to you during the Event by the organiser, you may be prohibited from further participation in the event.

13. Refusal

Pavestone reserves the right to refuse participation at any stage before or during the event.

14. Change of terms

Pavestone reserves the right to change these terms and conditions subject to notifying you of the changes. You shall be deemed to have accepted the amended terms and conditions by continuing to participate in the event.

15. English Law

These terms and conditions and your participation in the event are governed by English law, and you must submit to the jurisdiction of the courts of England.
